



AGAPE AT 3DAYSOFDESIGN COPENHAGEN 2025 HOSTED BY FILE UNDER POP

Agape will be bringing its aesthetics and refined design ethos to the Nordic region, hosted within the File Under Pop showroom during the annual 3daysofdesign fair in Copenhagen. The installation unfolds as a series of curated environments that reflect Agape and Agapecasa's distinctive approach to bathroom and interior design—where architectural rigour meets sensorial experience, and each element is conceived in relation to space, function, and form.

At the heart of the collaboration with File Under Pop lies a shared belief: that design begins with space. Both brands embrace the interior not as an isolated layer, but as a continuation of architecture itself—a dialogue between inside and outside, structure and atmosphere, function and sensibility. Through this shared lens of timeless design, honest materials, refined craftsmanship and innovation, the installation invites visitors into a moment of quiet contemplation and immersive reflection.

A carefully orchestrated sequence of spaces expresses Agape's evolving vision of the bathroom and beyond. The experience begins with a striking presentation of the Cenote washbasin by Patricia Urquiola, now framed by the new Bloque system—an architectural modular storage solution that adds rhythm and intimacy to the setting. This environment is enriched by the presence of the Lariana bathtub and Flat D shower, while elements such as Stairs, Rendez-vous, and Vis-à-vis reflect Agape's nuanced approach to functional, timeless design.

The path continues with a dedicated Agapecasa installation, where Angelo Mangiarotti's Eros dining table anchors a refined living area. Accompanied by Tre3 and Cavalletto, the composition pays tribute to Mangiarotti's unique ability to balance rational form with emotional resonance, drawing out the tactile and expressive potential of noble materials like marble.

The final environment brings Agape and Agapecasa into direct dialogue. At its centre stands a striking interpretation of the DR bathtub by Marcio Kogan, whose soft, elliptical form is reimagined for the occasion with a bespoke outer shell clad in thin, hand-laid ceramic tiles by File Under Pop. The finish, Under My Skin, lends the bathtub a refined chromatic depth, transforming it into a true sculptural highlight. Paired with the Bijhon1 washbasin and Voilà mirror, and completed by a configuration of Cavalletto, this environment embodies a layered dialogue of materiality, geometry, and emotion—bringing architectural precision and expressive detail into perfect balance.

Agape will also be presenting Framing the Project, a new publication offering a powerful visual and intellectual re-reading of one of Italy's most revered architects and designers. Edited by Anna Mainoli and Francesca Acerboni, the volume traces the close professional and personal connection between Angelo Mangiarotti and photographer Giorgio Casali. Drawing from the extensive Casali archive held at IUAV Venice, the book presents an extraordinary sequence of blackand-white images—many previously unpublished Mangiarotti's work —capturing architecture, product design, and experimental prototypes. Published by Corraini, Framing the Project is an invitation to rediscover Mangiarotti's work through a rare photographic lens and the eyes of those who carry his influence forward. The book, priced at €26, is now available for purchase at all major bookstores.

Agape will also be part of File Under Pop Casa at another official 3daysofdesign location, Papirøen, an emerging and trending neighborhood that puts the community at the forefront. File Under Pop Casa, an open house exhibition which transforms a townhouse into a sensory experience of interior design with textured surfaces, lighting and furniture, will feature fully functioning bathrooms by Agape.
